

## Chico Eye Center Contact Lens Exam Agreement

The charge for evaluating and determining your suitability for contact lens wear is not included in the comprehensive eye exam fee or refraction fee. A comprehensive eye exam must be performed prior to the contact lens exam. Your insurance plan may or may not cover the cost of the contact lens exam. The exam fee is for professional services and **does not include the cost of the lenses**.

**The following products and services are included in the contact lens exam fee:**

- Professional fitting of contact lens fit and power includes incidental revision of the lens
- Contact lens related follow-up care for 90 days
- Trial pair of contact lenses (if available)
- Professional insertion and removal training (if necessary)
- New contact lens case and trial size solution, or valuable coupon to purchase solution
- Manufacture rebates to purchase contact lenses through Chico Eye Center (if available)
